Volunteer Caregiver Spotlight Dr. Kimberly Kraus

Volunteer caregiver, Dr. Kimberly Kraus, OB/GYN sees herself in the women she cares for in her role at Womankind. When she was younger, unmarried and newly accepted to medical school, she found out she was pregnant with twins. While many people around her suggested she have an abortion, Dr. Kraus relied on her strong faith and chose to continue her pregnancy. “God definitely guided me through the pregnancy and my years in medical school, I couldn’t have done it without His guidance.” She sees the uncertainty, the vulnerability, and the need for hope in the client’s eyes during the clinics at Womankind.

Dr. Kraus has been volunteering her services at Womankind for almost 20 years and has helped numerous women through their pregnancy journey. She enjoys being able to give back to others. She loves being a physician and adds that being a volunteer caregiver at Womankind lets her do what she loves most and “It’s not a job when I’m there. Womankind is such a unique place where women can get direction, counseling and medical care all in one place.”

Along with her service to Womankind, Dr. Kraus volunteers for a yearly trip to Haiti with Haiti Outreach Ministries, where she spends a week in the country helping to take care of people who are in

need of healthcare. She practices mostly primary care and women’s health while in Haiti. Many women in the country deliver their babies at home, so she may see them before or after delivery. Dr. Kraus loves working side by side with Haitian healthcare providers. She says making the yearly journey to the impoverished nation helps her learn about other cultures as well as gives her a chance to give back to others. “It really helps remind me to be grateful, the people in Haiti don’t have the resources that we do here in the states.”

Dr. Kraus’ philosophy has always been to “be kind to others. It’s so important to me to look for opportunities to help, I really think that’s why we are all here.”

Dr. Kraus grew up in Toledo and attended the Medical College of Ohio. She loves living in Cleveland. In her

spare time, Dr. Kraus likes to spend time with her family, which includes her 27 year old twins, 16 year old daughter and her husband, Doug. She also enjoys music, traveling and reading, preferably on a beach.

If she wasn’t a physician, Dr. Kraus said she would have enjoyed being a detective. “Medicine is like detective work, there are so many questions and always something new to figure out.” We think she would have been a great detective, but we are glad she chose the path that led her to Womankind.

Womankind relies solely on the generosity of individuals, organizations, foundations and corporations for funding. Listed below are available giving options. All funds raised support the Womankind mission.

Some of these options include:

- **Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD):** A QCD allows taxpayers to make IRA distributions payable directly to a qualified charity without treating the distribution as taxable income. This law permits up to \$100,000 per eligible (70 ½ or older) IRA owner to be contributed directly from their IRA to a charity. In addition, the distribution can be used to fulfill the IRA owner's Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) for the year.
 - **Outright gifts of cash:** Womankind accepts cash, checks or credit card donations. Gifts can be made at www.womankindcleveland.org
 - **Gifts of appreciated assets:** Instead of cash gifts, you can avoid paying capital gains tax on the appreciated value of your investments, and potentially receive a tax deduction, by making a gift of appreciated stock, mutual funds, etc. directly to Womankind.
 - **Employer Matching Gift Programs:** Take advantage of your employer's corporate philanthropy initiatives that reward employees' charitable donations. This is an easy way to increase your overall support to Womankind.
 - **Named Beneficiary of retirement accounts, trusts, will and life insurance:** Your gift to Womankind would occur at death of the donor.
