On average, it costs Womankind approximately \$1,400 to cover the cost of care for one client. To that end, you may consider that:

- A donation of \$50 will provide 150 diapers for one baby.
- A donation of \$100 provides a safe place for a newborn baby to sleep.
- A donation of \$200 will cover one prenatal appointment for a pregnant woman.
- A donation of \$500 will cover all necessary items for a newborn baby including a car seat, clothing, diapers and other essential items.

It cannot be argued that this past year has presented all of us with overwhelming challenges which have changed just about every part of our daily lives; where we go, how we go, and even who we go with. We hope this letter finds you safe and well through it all.

Facing these challenges has caused Womankind to reflect on our purpose, our mission and how to serve our clients. 
